Grace to you and peace in the name of our loving God: the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit!



Dr. Richard Selzer, in his book *Mortal Lessons*, describes a scene in a hospital room after he had performed surgery on a young woman's face:

I stand by the bed where the young woman lies . . . her face, postoperative . . . her mouth twisted in palsy . . . clownish. A tiny twig of the facial nerve, one of the muscles of her mouth, has been severed. She will be that way from now on. I had followed with religious fervor the curve of her flesh, I promise you that. Nevertheless, to remove the tumor in her cheek, I had to cut this little nerve. Her young husband is in the room. He stands on the opposite side of the bed, and together they seem to be in a world all their own in the evening lamplight . . . isolated from me . . . private.

Who are they? I ask myself . . . he and this wry mouth I have made, who gaze at and touch each other so generously. The woman speaks. "Will my mouth always be like this?" she asks. "Yes," I say, "it will. It is because the nerve was cut." She nods and is silent. But the young man smiles. "I like it," he says. "It's kind of cute."

All at once I know who he is. I understand, and I lower my gaze. One is not bold in an encounter with the divine. Unmindful, he bends to kiss her crooked mouth, and I am so close I can see how he twists his own lips to accommodate hers . . . to show her that her kiss still works."

This is an image of the Church--as Jesus meant it to be. Not an organization, but people humble before God and one another. Not stiff-backed people, but people bending down to accommodate themselves to those whose lives have been twisted by sin. Isn't that what Christ Jesus did for us? Didn't God accommodate himself to us by coming down from wherever and whatever heaven is to greet us as a little baby? He...came...to us. He came not with a stiff back demanding of us "this and this, or else!" He came to us vulnerable and innocent. And, he allowed himself, his body, to be twisted on a cross to show us, beyond the shadow of a doubt, God's love for each of us, ... to show us that God's love for us still works regardless of our scars. Despite the ravages that sin has inflicted upon us, God still sees us as beautiful and worth his love, his attention, his grace. We each have been created in his image, and we bear his likeness. He will never stop loving us.

As God's own, redeemed by his undying love for us, we are called and blessed to live into his image. Assured by his grace, willing and able to bend down and twist ourselves (the Church of flesh and bones, mind and spirit) to those yet twisted and tied and captive to sin—to show them God's love still works.

It's not about our "rights;" it's about our righteous God, our Savior and Lord, and his will to redeem all people. So, if God loves each of us in such a profound way, how is it that we have so much trouble loving one another?

Perhaps you are like me? In need of letting go of old slights and biases. In need of forgiveness and the will to forgive. In need of new and more God-like eyes and ears and heart. Lord, help us one and all; and constantly remind us . . .

Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Love never ends. [1 Corinthians 13:4-8a]

I pray that each of you have a joyful, faithful, meaningful, restful, loving-filled, summer.

**12.0 Adjournment:** Meeting adjourned at 8:02 with the Lord's Prayer.



We appreciate your cooperation and willingness to follow the guidance provided to us from the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH). With everyone's compliance the indoor worship services will be reasonably safe and hopefully comfortable for all to attend. Here are the practices that will allow us to have indoor worship:

- \*While the mask mandate has been lifted by the Governor, for those who are vaccinated, many of our younger members have not yet had access to he vaccine. So, in solidarity with our younger members who are now the most vulnerable to the COVID-19 virus, we ask and recommend that all indoor worshipers continue to mask.
- \*All people entering the building will need to sign in and provide a contact number. This is for contact tracing should the church be informed that someone attending has been diagnosed with COVID-19.
- \*Congregational singing is now allowed, if masked, as long as there is 6 ft. distance between households.

For those who are uncomfortable with returning to indoor worship, we will be broadcasting the 10:00 am indoor worship service over the radio into the parking lot. In addition to the 10:00 am indoor service being broadcast into the parking lot each Sunday, beginning June 13th we will be adding an outdoor only service at 11:00 am for those who would like to continue seeing Pastor Randy. The online live stream will continue at the new time of 10:00 am.
