Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Grace and peace to you in the name of our loving God: the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

In the mid-1990's, editor and publisher of *LectioAid*, Glendon E. Harris shared a story he had read in *Colliers* magazine many years before. I have edited his version of the story slightly.

There was a girl in an orphanage who was unattractive and had annoying mannerisms. She was female, but not feminine; a lot of body, but very little shape. The orphanage director, knowing that no one was likely to adopt the girl, looked for, and longed for, a reason to get rid of her. Finally, one afternoon an opportunity presented itself. The obnoxious girl had been seen outside the orphanage wall pinning a note to a tree. The director and other officials rushed out to the tree to get the note as sufficient evidence whereby they could send the girl to reform school and get her out of their hair. The director grabbed the note and hurriedly read it. Then she paused a moment. She had to turn away from the others as tears began to well up in her eyes and chip away at her hardened countenance. On the note was printed these six words: "Whoever finds this, I love you."

I have three take-aways from this story. First, I find that often it is those tasks or those people who seem to be a hinderance to me are, actually, those things or experiences or people who break my heart open to God. Isn't it peculiar and cathartic how God so often chooses to work?

Second, the note from that orphan girl reminds me of another note written and posted on a different tree nearly 2,000 years ago. Of the writer of that previous note it is written, "He had no form or majesty that we should look at him, nothing in his appearance that we should desire him. He was despised and rejected by others . . ." So too, the leaders back then looked for, longed for, and sought out a reason to get rid of him. Finally, an opportunity presented itself, and they nailed him to a tree. But his love for all was so deep that from upon that tree, from upon that cross, he asked forgiveness for his crucifiers, including you and me. "Father, forgive them for they know not what they are doing." So it is that upon that tree, Jesus, God-in-the- flesh, has left the timeless message, "Whoever finds this, I love you."

Third, because this despised one and his note have broken our hearts open to God's grace, we now have the freedom (and the wisdom, courage, and calling) to help others discover the timeless message. Knowing that we are accepted, knowing whose we, it is now who we are and what we are about.

It is that simple.

I hope and pray that you are all having a good summer. May God provide enough sun and rain, enough hard work and joyous play, enough friends and family time, enough nurture and support that we might all together thrive and give thanks for every good gift!


