

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,





I'm guessing that the name Ruth Ryan is not familiar to you. However, if you are a baseball fan, her husband's name, Nolan Ryan, rings all kinds of bells. Nolan Ryan was a pitcher for four major league teams: the New York Mets, the California Angels, the Houston Astros, and the Texas Rangers. Nolan is in the Baseball Hall of Fame and, though retired since 1993, still holds several all-time records.

In her book *Covering Home*, Ruth writes of one moment she looked forward to in every one of her husband's games:

It probably happened the first time on the high-school baseball diamond in Alvin, Texas, in the mid-1960s. Then it happened repeatedly for three decades after that. Inevitably, sometime during a game, Nolan would pop up out of the dugout and scan the stands behind home plate, looking for me. He would find my face and grin at me, maybe snapping his head up in a quick nod as if to say, There you are; I'm glad. I'd wave and flash him a smile. Then he'd duck under the roof and turn back to the game.

It was a simple moment, never noted in record books or career summaries. But of all the moments in all the games, it was the one most important to me.

I'm guessing that is somewhat universal. Those who love us yearn for us to acknowledge them, to give them our attention. This is true not only in marriage and family, but in our relationship with God. Throughout our days, in both big and small moments, God enjoys it when we "step out of the dugout" and smile in his direction, acknowledging him for all he is and all he does for us. While this should happen every day, multiple times a day, November has a special day set aside for all of us, together, to step out of our dugouts, scan the stands for his face, then flash him a smile, a nod of the head, and a quick prayer. That, in a nutshell, is Thanksgiving.

But there is something more in this "giving of thanks." It doesn't just make God feel good, it does something to us as well. Living with gratitude has its own rewards. V. Norskov Olsen, former president of Loma Linda University wrote:

Thankfulness leaves no room for discouragement. I once read a legend of a man who found the barn where Satan kept his seeds ready to be sown in the human heart, and on finding the seeds of discouragement more numerous than others, he learned that the seeds could be made to grow almost anywhere. When Satan was questioned, he reluctantly admitted that there was one place in which he could never get them to thrive. "And where is that?" asked the man. Satan replied sadly, "In the heart of a grateful person."

I wish you all a joyful, gratitude-filled Thanksgiving, not just on that one Thursday in November, but in everyday and every moment of your existence! Take care and God bless!

The last year and a half has been a struggle for most people, not just mentally, but financially. Our church is no different. We, too, have struggled mentally (What are we going to do? How do we keep people safe and still do what we are called to do? How can we be a church community when our normal community activities are threatening our health and safety and cohesiveness?), and financially. In the latter case, the charts below show that we are significantly behind where we need to be if we want to end this fiscal year debt free. As of the end of August we have completed 67% of the year, and our giving to date covers only 46% of that needed for the year.

So, what do our monthly operating expenses include:

- A Pastor to facilitate the needs of the community and help us all deepen our relationship with the God. This Pastor is also on call when times are hard.
- An office manager to help ensure the day to day tasks are taken care of. Without this position, we no longer have a point of contact to book events, create and print bulletins for worship, or do many other behind the scenes things that need to get done.

Without the needed financial support from our congregation, we will have to begin cutting positions. We have pared down the budget as far as we can in all other areas. And, if one or more of these positions is cut, it is going to make all the other positions much more challenging.
- An organist and contemporary worship coordinator to ensure our worship services are enjoyable and to fulfill our need to sing praises to the Lord. During this pandemic we realized how crucial it is to be able to praise the Lord through song.

So, what can we do? If you think about it, all it takes is skipping that morning coffee stop, going out to eat one less time a month, and putting that money in the offering plate instead. 
