Grace and peace to you in the name of our loving God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. I love April. I love April because, to me, it represents hope in a very concrete way. The lyrics to one of my favorite Easter hymns, *Now the Green Blade Rises*, gives image to the origins of this hope better than any words I could hope to string together....



Now the green blade rises from the buried grain, Wheat that in dark earth many days has lain; Love lives again, that with the dead has been; Love is come again like wheat arising green.

It is something about those first shoots of whatever plant it may be emerging from the soil--after a long, typically colorless, and often hard winter--that crisp, wonderful spring green color that makes my heart swell with joy and turns my lips to a beaming smile. I smile and swell with joy because that green is a concrete reminder of my Savior's victory over sin, death, and the power of the devil. In that Savior, hope springs eternal, not just for me, but for every man, woman, and child, every creature of our God and King.

In the grave they laid him, love by hatred slain, Thinking that he would never wake again, Laid in the earth like grain that sleeps unseen; Love is come again like wheat arising green.

> Phillips Brooks, in his poetry, puts it this way Tomb, thou shalt not hold Him longer; Death is strong, but Life is stronger; Stronger than the dark, the light; Stronger than the wrong, the right; Faith and Hope triumphant say, Christ will rise on Easter Day.

Forth he came at Easter, like the risen grain, He that for three days in the grave had lain; Raised from the dead, my living lord is seen; Love is come again like wheat arising green.

How tragic it is when supposed Christians don't recognize this God and Savior for who he is and what he is about. Again, other's words are so much more expressive than mine—

Some of us stay at the cross, some of us wait at the tomb,

Quickened and raised with Christ yet lingering still in the gloom.

Some of us 'bide at the Passover feast with Pentecost all unknown,

The triumphs of grace in the heavenly place that our Lord has made His own.

If the Christ who died had stopped at the cross, His work had been incomplete.

If the Christ who was buried had stayed in the tomb, He had only known defeat,

But the way of the cross never stops at the cross and the way of the tomb leads on

To victorious grace in the heavenly place where the risen Lord has gone.


