Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Grace and peace to you in the name of our loving God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

"Last night we performed for just a handful of people. Fewer will come tonight. Why not give back their meager fees and cancel the concert? No one can expect us to go on when just a few are in attendance." "How can anyone do his best for so few?" inserted another. This last one then turned to another sitting beside him and asked, "What do you think?" The man of whom he asked this question was considerably older than the others. He looked straight back at his questioner and the other troupe members and said, "I know you are discouraged. I am too. But we have a responsibility to those who might come. We will go on. And, we will do the best job of which we are capable. It is not the fault of those who come that others do not. They should not be punished with less than the best we can give."

Heartened and inspired by his words, the minstrels went ahead with their show. They had never performed better. When the show was over and the small audience gone, the older man called his fellow troupe members to him. In his hand was a note, handed to him by one of the audience members as they were leaving. The older man said, "Listen to this, my friends!" There was something electric in his voice that caught all of their attention. The older man unfolded the note, and then proceeded to read from it proudly, "Thank you for a beautiful performance." It was signed very simply — "Your King."

Life is complicated, and often, quite messy. We can easily become discouraged. God knew discouragement is a terrible product of this fallen world--so he came to us in the person of Jesus to set us free to be all we can be. That is Christ's purpose and pleasure. In him, we, too, find our purpose and our joy as we share ourselves with one another..
