The meeting opened with Devotions by Jessi.

- 1.0 Approval of agenda: Bruce made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition of 5.4 seconded by Steph. Motion carried.
- 2.0 Approval of July 2022 Council minutes: Bruce made a motion to approve the minutes seconded by Diane. Motion Carried.
- 3.0 Treasurer's report July 2022: Kevin made a motion to approve the treasurer's report Seconded by Joyce. Motion carried.
- 4.0 Ongoing business:
  - 4.1 Technology update: N/A
  - 4.2 COVID situation update: N/A
  - 4.3 Foundation Account signers: Some accounts have multiple signers others only one. Moving to have two signers on all accounts. Renae being the second signer on all accounts as the Treasurer. Bruce moves to approve the recommendation of the Foundation board for signers on their accounts, Diane 2<sup>nd</sup>. Council carried the motion.
  - 4.4 Wedding Booklet: Jessi sent in edits with a few questions for Randy to look over. Will be looked over and presented to council at the meeting in September for approval

Community Care Committee (Joyce): Met and have decided to shift gears, care bags will always be available but they are moving their focus to promoting birthday bags again as they were so well received by the pantries last year. They will start that Rally Sunday and go through November/December. Looking at sponsoring a child/ren from Haiti in place of a

missionary, this would cost \$36 a month and they are thinking that can be funded through a noisy offering once a month.

Church Property (Marlowe): Freak accident with some water damage during the last big storm. Some damage to the retaining wall from snow removal this fall, making mowing more difficult. Talk about adding stakes or reflectors to mark that area better and avoid further damage. Weed control and fertilizer need to be addressed as what we have been doing is no longer an option. Two lights have gone out needing to be replaced and maybe should be placed on pedestals. Propane tank should be filled before prices go away from summer pricing. Breakers being addressed and needing to be labeled after recent work done.

Stewardship (Kevin): Will meet on the 21<sup>st</sup> following worship to plan for the year ahead.

**12.0 Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned at 8:31 pm with the Lord's Prayer.
