Grace and peace to you in the name of God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Perhaps my favorite Christmas song is not one of the traditional Christmas hymns. No, my favorite Christmas song was written by an American composer, Katherine Kennicott Davis, in 1941. Originally titled "Carol of the Drum," it now is known as, "The Little Drummer Boy."

Shall I play for you, pa rum pum pum, On my drum?

Mary nodded, pa rum pum pum pum
The ox and lamb kept time, pa rum pum pum pum
I played my drum for Him, pa rum pum pum pum
I played my best for Him, pa rum pum pum pum,
Rum pum pum pum, rum pum pum pum,

Then He smiled at me, pa rum pum pum Me and my drum.



I love this song because it's simple, yet so very powerful, as it speaks of the heart of our loving God. This God who created the wonder and majesty of this world and the vastness of the universe which surrounds it, is not so mighty that he forgets the tiny specks that we, essentially, are within this massive and beautiful creation. Instead, knowing our frailty, desperation, and need, he chooses to enter into his own creation to be here with us. And he doesn't come arrayed with all the trappings of a God or king, and the layers of security that would keep us at more than an arm's length. He comes, instead, in the vulnerability of a babe, born in a foul-smelling stable, to a poor peasant girl and her humble carpenter husband, in a dry, dusty corner that was little more than nowhere.

This is the God I see in the song "The Little Drummer Boy"—a God who meets us where we are. A God who accepts us as we are—rich or poor, refined or rough, young or old, happy or sad, black or white or red or brown or yellow. None of that matters. And, he doesn't expect magnificent wonders from us. But, when in our humility we "play our best for him"—whatever our gifts or talents might be, this God cannot help but smile.

What are your gifts, your talents? Are they fit for this King? You, like the little drummer boy, may not think so, but they are—whatever they may be. And there is nothing better than when you choose to share your gifts with him.

Today, we may not find him in a stable, but all we need to do is look around and we will find him. . .

Then the king will say to those at his right hand, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world, for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me, something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me.' Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food or thirsty and gave you something to drink? And when was it that we saw

you a stranger and welcomed you or naked and gave you clothing? And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you?' And the king will answer them, 'Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it to me.' [Matthew 25: 34-40]

My prayer for each of us this Christmas is that we might find a way to play our best for "Him" wherever we find him.

Then he smiled at me, pa rum pum pum pum, me and my drum.
