Not so certain of baseball's rules, he caught it. Final out! Dad's team lost! Quickly, my father told his team to cheer. The boy beamed. It never occurred to him that he lost the game. All he knew was he had hit the ball and caught it--both for the first time. His parents later thanked my dad. Their child had never even gotten in a game before that season.

We never told the boy exactly what happened. We didn't want to ruin it for him. And till this day, I'm proud of what my father did that afternoon.

In a world where sports seems to be a god for so many people, and winning the ultimate glory, Jeffrey Zaslow's father showed the power and majesty of the one true God—full of mercy and grace.




# Rothsay Prairie Days Breakfast


