Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

O come, let us sing to the Lord; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation! Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise! For the Lord is a great God! [Psalm 95:1-3a]

In Thorton Wilder's Pulitzer Prize winning play *Our Town*, the main character, Emily, discovers the joy of living life fully only too late. After she is dead, she pleads with the spirits to allow her to return and look in on one day of her life, one last time. She chooses the day of her 12<sup>th</sup> birthday.

At first, Emily rejoices as she watches her parents and others from her childhood, but her happiness quickly turns to pain as she realizes how little people appreciate the simple activities of life. At one point she says, "all that was going on, and we never noticed. . . It goes so fast. We don't have time to look at one another." The recognition proves too painful for her, and she realizes that every moment of life should be treasured. Her parting words were, "Good-bye! Good-bye world. Good-bye Grover's corners . . . Mama and Papa. Good-bye to clocks ticking . . . and Mama's sunflowers, and food and coffee. And even ironed dresses and hot baths . . . sleeping and waking up. O earth, you're too wonderful for anybody to realize you." She stoops, hesitates, and asks with tears in her eyes, "Do any human beings ever realize life while they live it? Eh? . . . every minute?"

I'm guessing, none of us do, . . . not fully, not every minute. And, because of this, we don't give thanks to the One who gave us this world and everything and everyone in it. We don't give him thanks every minute for every minute—and as a result, life is less than it could be and should be.

Friends, Jesus came among us to change all that. The Holy Spirit, even now, is working in us, to make us more alive every day. One of the marks of our spiritual growth is an expanding awareness of the glories of our everyday experience—a growing sense of how truly precious and miraculous the ordinary is.

The holiday of Thanksgiving is a lot of things to a lot of people; but most especially, it is an opportunity for us to remind ourselves how truly blessed we are, and then to give thanks to the One who has blessed us so.

   Mission Trip. The students interested in going will help pick the destination

- Pastor Randy purchased biblical puppets to begin puppet ministry
- John Reber has been in contact with Park Region Telephone about the Summit Fire Protection signal not getting through. There is an issue at this time and they are working on fixing it.
- The church has received a proposal for a new copier from Liberty. Marco is currently drawing up a proposal. Our current contract with Marco ends in December 2025
- The NW MN Fall Theological Conference is September 14th-16th and costs \$400 to attend. Pastor Randy is not going to attend this year.
- An Energy Assessment Report was prepared for NLLC by Otter Tail Power Company. A rebate was filled out by Renae and sent in. We have already made the updates they suggested and are running efficiently.

Pastor Randy has put together "Offering Snippets" to be shared prior to receiving offer at church services. This practice is suggested in stewardship resources, and was suggested by Rebel (from the Synod Staff) when he met with her last month.




